GB		<p><i>2012 London Olympics</i></p> <p>Royal Mail will issue a sheetlet of 6 NVI 1st stamps for each gold medal winner. As host country, they have high expectations of the number of medal winners, and expect to exceed their tally of 20 at the last Olympic Games.</p> <p>At present, no formal details have been released, but there are reportedly 6 printers around the country who will produce the sheetlets as the medals are won together with a central printer who will produce a "formal" set of sheetlets at the end of the games.</p> <p>We also do not know for sure whether the stamps will be PVA or self adhesive. If they are the former, singles can be provided from a sheetlet. If the latter, this may not be so easy to achieve.</p> <p>Furthermore, which copies will be provided by Tallents House has still to be announced.</p> <p>However, customers need to consider their requirements now.</p> <p>We will advise you when more information comes to hand.</p> <p>With each sheetlet costing £3.60, this will not be a cheap exercise.</p>
