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

		<p><i>This booklet is a first in that stamp Panes 1 & 2 (& associated text panes) are inserted upright relative to the front cover.</i></p> <p><i>The remaining stamp panes (Panes 3-5) and associated text panes are inserted inverted relative to the front cover, but upright relative to the back cover. The back cover may be distinguished by the barcode.</i></p> <p><i>This PSB was issued at a premium of 95p above face.</i></p> <p><i>In this booklet, all panes are printed by Cartor in litho</i></p> <p><i>Acknowledgments within the booklet attribute the self adhesive mini sheet pane to Joh Enschedé and the multi value Machin pane to Walsall (& gravure).</i></p> <p><i>These have now been corrected in the philatelic press to attribute all printing to Cartor and by litho.</i></p> <p><i>The multi-value pane has solid, non-gradated A2B phosphor bands whilst the other pva panes have shaped all over A2B phosphor [AOP].</i></p> <p><i>The self adhesive M/S pane has a central phosphor band for the NVI 2nd and two (double) bands for the NVI 1st stamp.</i></p>

		<p>The pva stamps from Panes 1 - 4 are identical to the corresponding sheet stamps, all being printed by Cartor by litho.</p> <p>The M/S pane differs slightly from the Enschedé printed M/S in that the NVI 2nd phosphor bands have a thicker phosphor coating with crisp clean edges.</p> <p>The M/S phosphor is thinner and each band has 2 clear tiny edge lines. For the NVI 1st Tardis stamp, the phosphor bands from the PSB pane are much wider than those from the M/S.</p> <p>The TARDIS stamps from the retail booklet are a larger stamp (17.5 x 21.5mm) than those from the minisheet and PSB (17 x 21mm).</p> <p>Thus there are three very different self adhesive TARDIS stamps for this issue. [Smilers (the 4th sa) attributes are unknown, as we no longer acquire them].
