GB		Machin collectors will recall the difficulties experienced by De La Rue with their printing presses when producing the 27.3.13 definitive issue. As a result, they were forced to subcontract the <i>denominated</i> sheet stamps to Walsall at that time. However, DLR did produce the stamp pack. Stamps for packs come from specially produced jumbo rolls which are then guillotined for the pack. Sheet stamps are rouletted for ease of use. Thus, on the issue date, the pack stamps were produced by DLR, the

		<p>denominated sheet stamps by Walsall, and the NVI sheet stamps by DLR. The denominated sheet stamps have now been printed by DLR and have been released into general use on a needs basis. There is no official FDI. Specialised Machin collectors will appreciate that Deegam classifies and numbers stamps by <i>source</i>.</p> <p>Thus a stamp which comes from a sheet is given a different number to one from a PSB (for example) even though the two stamps may have identical characteristics. So it is with this issue.</p> <p>Sheet stamps (rouletted backing paper) have different DG numbers to corresponding pack stamps (guillotined backing paper). We do not normally acquire packs but have done so on this occasion to obtain the DLR guillotined stamps.</p> <p>These, plus the new DLR denominated sheet stamps are listed below. Also note that the Walsall stamps have year code M13L whereas the DLR stamps have year code MA13.</p> <p>Correction: The New Issue Chronicle incorrectly showed the Royal Mail Signed For [DLR] issues of 27.3.13 as M13L instead of MA13. Please adjust your collection labels accordingly.</p>

<i>The Aqony of Canada Post</i>							
<p>Canada collectors will recall our missive in the Q2-13 New Issue Chronicle concerning delivery of stamps to international customers by seamaile.</p> <p>Well, their latest dispatches tacitly confirm that this is to be permanent policy. Furthermore, the packaging has diminished in quality so that in-transit damage is now more likely.</p> <p>We have had no response to our protestations and now expect to receive none. It is our assessment that it is futile to pursue it. The choice is either to live with it or abandon collecting Canada stamps. Our customers have asked us to continue. That is an easy option for them, as they do not incur any pain. We do!</p> <p>However, in recent months, the reasons for CPs decisions have crystallised. Essentially, they are broke and bleeding at around \$100 million per quarter. This has prompted a five point action plan some of which will affect Canada collectors. From 11 December 2013, all NVI P stamps have been removed from sale at all outlets including philatelic. This includes everything that included a mint P stamp -- booklets, rolls, quarterly and annual packs, yearbooks.</p> <p>The reason is to prevent customers stocking up on base postage rate stamps to somewhat mitigate the horrendous price rises which will shortly occur.</p>

		 <p>Scan from the Canada Post web site</p> <p>New (denominated) 63¢ stamps will be issued on that day for the base postage rate. Whilst some details remain unclear, it is likely that there will be booklets of 10 & rolls (?) but no FDCs. The new definitives will be the current (withdrawn) Flag & Queen P designs, but now denominated. Scans of these are above.</p> <p>The CP web site has removed all P stamps from sale in all formats.</p> <p>Effective 31 March 2014, the base postage rate will rise to 85¢, a 35% increase. However purchase of single stamps (in quantities of less than a booklet of 10 or roll of 50) will rise to \$1 -- a 59% increase, a strategy most likely to affect the disadvantaged rather than the wealthy. CP calls this "tiered pricing".</p> <p>And last, but certainly not least, all home delivery of mail will be phased out over a five year period. Instead, mail will be delivered to community mail boxes.</p> <p>And so the nightmare begins for Canadians.</p> <p>If you would like to find out more about these, just Google "community mail boxes" and endure hours of unhappy reading.</p> <p>Basically, community mail boxes are an array of individual locked boxes for a community, just like you see in a retirement village. Larger shared boxes exist for parcels. They have been on trial in Canada for some time and have resulted in a deluge of box holder complaints especially for non delivery and/or theft.</p> <p>You can not click on the following URLs as you are reading a pdf file. Superman Stamps</i></p> <p>Did you know that there is a licensing restriction prohibiting Canada Post selling these stamps outside Canada? But there is nothing to stop Canadian residents, dealers etc selling them in the secondary market and probably making a killing. Fortunately, our standing order is for quarterly packs which contained the relevant stamps -- a single coil, a strip of 5 and a M/S. Some sanity from Canada Post at last. Standing order customers will receive them at their usual price. New customers or extra orders will be supplied at a premium.
