GB	28.7.14	<p>The Great War - 1914 (1st) (2B) ex sheets The Great War - 1914 PSB <i>This PSB was issued at a premium of 95p above face.</i> All panes were printed by Joh Enschedé by litho. The stamps in Panes 1 & 2 were printed by Enschedé with all over phosphor (AOP) whereas the sheet stamps were printed by Cartor with two phosphor bands. The 10p, 20p & £1.00 Machins in Panes 3 & 4 with code MPIL / M14L appeared in the Buckingham Palace PSB and thus are not new. However, there are subtle differences. The £1 value is a lighter shade than that in the previous book and the phosphor bands are shiny whereas in the previous book they are matt. Pane 3 is also the first PSB pane to contain only one stamp. The 4 Regionals in Pane 4 were issued previously in the British Army Uniforms PSB (litho by Enschedé), and thus are not new.</p>	2B	C/L E/L

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GB		<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Barcodes</i></p> <p>For commercial expediency, Royal Mail has considered a policy of applying barcodes to <i>all</i> products. This principally affects Miniature Sheets.</p> <p>As a trial, a barcode stub was attached to the Buckingham Palace and Great British Films Mini Sheets and these were sold through retail outlets. Tallents House continued to distribute these <i>M/S without</i> the barcode.</p> <p>The retail trial has now been deemed a success with the result that, in future, starting with the British Piers <i>M/S, all M/S</i> will now bear a barcode.</p> <p>Strangely, however, it has been deemed that the barcodes are philatelically unattractive so that <i>M/S on FDC's</i> and in packs and annual collections will <i>NOT</i> bear a barcode. Presumably the barcode will appear on the back of the FDC or pack etc.</p> <p>This policy seems very inconsistent to us and our conspiracy juices are on the boil. Is this just another scheme to induce us all to now buy <i>M/S packs</i> as well retail <i>M/S</i> so that we can get a <i>M/S</i> without an unattractive barcode?</p> <p><i>M/S</i> without the barcode will <i>NOT</i> be available from Tallents House for future issues.</p> <p>We do not obtain packs as new issues.</p> <p>Also to maintain the integrity of your collection, unattractive as they may be, we strongly urge you <i>not</i> to remove or fold under the barcode tabs from future <i>M/S</i> issues.</p>

GB		<p style="text-align: center;"><i>Forgeries</i></p> <p>Modern computer technology allows us to do wonderful things, but it also allows those of nefarious ways do embellish their trade too.</p> <p>I am referring to the seemingly endless number of Machin forgeries which are surprisingly appearing in the UK with monotonous regularity.</p> <p>Most of them would have to be described as "very good" (rather than crude) and would easily deceive postal employees processing large volumes of mail items.</p> <p>Vendors of these scams usually sell their "art" at deeply discounted prices to</p>					

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		<p>UK retail outlets such as chemists, newsagents, petrol stations etc who naively do not subject them to careful scrutiny on acquisition. A 30%+ discount is difficult to resist. Most forgeries are in the form of booklets, complete with iridescent overlay, phosphor bars and source/date codes, although not necessarily the right ones.</p> <p>Specialist Machin collectors can quickly determine their status, but not so the unsuspecting retailers and the public at large.</p> <p>It is costing Royal Mail a small fortune in lost revenue.</p> <p>In an endeavour to further deter forgers, Royal Mail is introducing further security measures in the form of a security inscription on the entire backing paper for self adhesives -- counter sheets, coils, booklets and business sheets. It remains to be seen just how this will be incorporated into each product.</p> <p>The start date is said to be 2015.</p>
