Sadly, the AUD is at its lowest rate for 19 years against the USD and has also fallen sharply against the GBP & EUR. This has meant that new issues have increased in price. Put this together with annual tariff increases for the UK, Canada & France, and the result is that new issue stamps have become quite expensive.

Canada France  UK		<b>The COVID-19 Consequences (so far)</b> Stamps have arrived and are supplied herewith. Have finally responded to my e-mails. They have been in total lockdown and have only just returned to work but still with social distancing. They will have a backlog of orders to process so stamps will be delayed until the Q2-20 dispatch. Words fail me here and I would like to use a language which would make a sailor blush. The James Bond issue has gone missing -- over \$1000 worth. Royal Mail is refusing to refund or replace because I did not inform them within a designated time. So far, they have shown no acknowledgment of the COVID-19 impact on the world's supply chains. Despite operating with a greatly reduced staff and with 80%+ of the world's airlines grounded, they assess the problem within a normal framework. The consequence for a patient customer of 35+ years is "screw the customer". I am still awaiting a response from them for my objection. If unsatisfactory, I will pursue the matter further. In the interim, I will have to reorder the James Bond issue and pay for it again. Once one of the very best philatelic administrations in the world, they are now clearly one of the worst - robotic, insensitive and unthinking. The James Bond issue will be supplied in the Q2-20 dispatch, assuming I can get them. PS - All subsequent issues and all normal RM advices, newsletters etc are also "missing".

France		France has been one of the worst affected countries in Europe from COVID-19 and has been in lockdown. The philatelic bureau is now back at work but with social distancing in place and many staff working from home. It is hoped that normal operations will return soon. In the interim, orders will be serviced, but with delays and with delivery delays until more planes are back in the air.						
<b>Q2-20 DISPATCH</b>								
GB		Well, the "missing" James Bond issue arrived 27.5.20 a little battered due to inadequate packing but repackaged by AP -- no thanks to Tallents House. My second complaint was dismissed the same as the first "you advised us too late". No response was given to my 3 queries about registered post & track & trace. It was registered so RM could have easily followed this process. However they chose to dismiss my complaint. A third complaint "up the line" remains unanswered. Clearly, in reaching their determination, they are not prepare to take any other relevant facts into account like 35+ years as a substantial customer and all the postal service issues associated with COVID-19. Clearly, they are totally corporate and not customer centric -- a really appalling situation. The End of WW2 issue arrived the same day after only 19 days in transit -- not the 2.3 months for James Bond.
