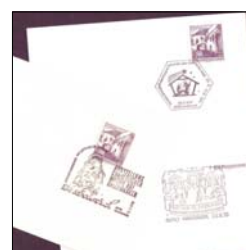

34-2 **Austria:** Rubber-stamped addressed commercial envelope with special commemorative cancel for the Olympic Torch Relay in Austria, Vienna, 29th July 1936. Host nation Germany initiated the first ever Olympic Torch Relay from Greece to the Opening Ceremony venue for the 1936 Olympics, a tradition continued at all subsequent Games. Nice clear postmark. Top edge of cover slightly bent with a small tear, otherwise OK.

34-3 **Austria:** Lot of 3 different special postmarks: 25.3.66 Christian Themed Stamp Show by the Austrian Philatelic Society; 25.9.70 Festival of Archangel St Gabriel Stamp Show; and 29.11-2.12.12.74 8th International Congress of World Christian Fellowship - all Innsbruck on plain unaddressed cover or card.

34-4 **East Germany:** 1960 10pf Liner *Fritz Heckert* stamp error, MUH. The error is misplaced horizontal perforations by at least 3mm resulting in the imprint "PRIESS" appearing at the very top of the stamp and not at the bottom. In the image here, the MUH error is shown at the right and can be contrasted with a normally perforated FU example on the left. The error has been collected complete with bottom margin showing "PRIESS" again.

34-6 Germany - Weimar Republic: Large part of plain letter with multiple strikes of Berlin - Schöneberg CDS dated 14.9.23 tying SG 242 2,000m blue x 4 and SG 261100m purple x 20 definitives to cover. The top row front and back of the 100m value are trimmed from slicing open the envelope. There is a pinhole through a 100m stamp on the front and a 2,000m stamp on the back. An inflation period example of compliance with rapidly rising postal rates!

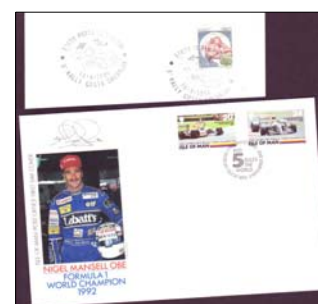

34-9 Germany - Storkow Local Issue: 12pf black / yellowish City Crest definitive tied to Storkow (Mark) Court Office cover with Storkow (peace, tranquility) CDS dated 6.3.46. Cover is addressed to Landlord Kuhnt in nearby Kummersdorf. While the stamp is missing the top right edge and the cover mutilated by two punch holes and the centre cut out of the Court Office circular area bottom left, the cover remains collectible regular mail of this period.

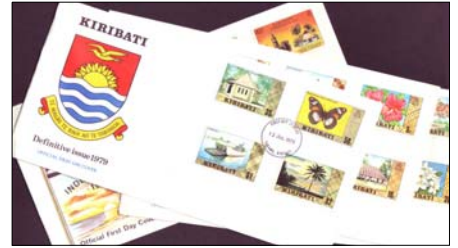

- 34-12 Lundy:** Lundy Millenary set 7 values overprinted Europa 1961 affixed to back of Lundy Europa FDC, cancelled Lundy 8th December 1961. The front of the cover is addressed with Barnstaple machine cancel also for the 8th December. GB 2d CEPT and 1d Wilding stamps are on the front of the cover. This tallish cover is toned along the top edge.

- 34-13 Netherlands:** Souvenir wallet for the 1981 Centenary of Parcel Post. Wallet contains 2 blocks of 4 of the 45¢ Parcel Post stamp, one MUH and the other with CTO "POST / POST" double circular cancel. The wallet also contains the PTT Centenaries M/S MUH. The message from the Director is to fellow workers of the Post.

- 34-14 Postal History - Papua and New Guinea:** Pair of plain covers with CDS Rabaul PNG - 10th May 1952 for 6½d brown KGVI, 15th July 1952 for 6½d green KGVI - demonstrating the use of Australian stamps in PNG post World War II to early 1953. These covers predate the issue of the first pictorial definitives for the combined Territory of Papua and New Guinea. Typical for commercially used covers, both have a few creases, and the flap on one is rather mangled. However, the stamps and cancels have survived intact.

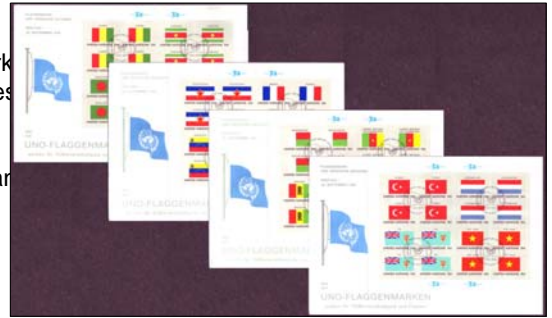

FILATELICA PORTO / 31.1.50" [3rd FLAVEX Philatelic Exhibition] CDS to address side. Same postmark on reverse, along with Espinho 2.2.50 CDS. FLAVEX artistic-humour theme label affixed to back, also pictorial FLAVEX cachet in black ink. Toned.

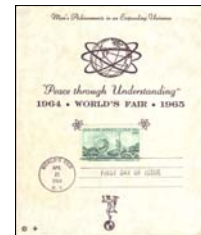
34-17 United Nations - New York: Set of clean unaddressed FDCs for first issue of Flags of Member Nations 26th September 1980 ie 4 separate covers each with a complete sheetlet with UN NY pictorial FDI postmark. The cachet shows the UN flag and the inscriptions are in German. These covers are necessarily large measuring a little over 25cm x 17.5cm.



Notably, each cover contains the sheetlet varieties: the central se-tenar blocks of 4 and the stamps with margin inscription.
