	<p>Pane 1 contains 4 new stamps -- all PVA gummed. Previous issues of the Olympic and Paralympic Games definitives have all been self adhesive from booklets and counter and business sheets. The remaining panes contain select commemorative stamps from the Games run-up issues of 2010-11. They are identical to those issues including the micro dates. Thus, although the se-tenant combinations are new, the stamps are not. All panes in the booklet are PVA gum.</p> <p>Inasmuch as Pane 1 produces only 1 set of Games definitives, it is not economical for us to break up the booklet. However, this PSB remains the only source of the PVA Games definitives.</p>

So far, these are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NVI 1st letter and large letter - from gold to red. At present, it is unclear whether this is a reversion to the previous bright orange red (aka flame) or a new shade of red.</li> <li>An iridescent overlay is to be applied to the 1p - 20p low makeup values issued in counter sheets. If existing practice continues, they will have no source code, but will most likely have a date code.</li> <li>The 50p and £1 Machins will be issued in new (unannounced) colours. This will probably mean new counter sheets, business sheets, booklets and coils. Joy!</li> </ol>
