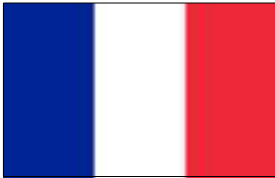

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CATALOGUES

Collectors frequently ask us what is the best catalogue to use for France.

The answer depends on which level you wish to collect, however no one catalogue has all the answers.

Each of the specialist catalogues provides pieces of information not contained in the others.

For the basic or simplified collector [catalogue language is shown in brackets]:

Scott Catalogue Volume 2 C-F [English]

Stanley Gibbons: Stamps of the World Volume 2 C-G [English]

For the intermediate collector:

Michel: Europa-Katalog Band 3 Westeuropa: Frankreich [German]

Stanley Gibbons: (green series): France [English]

Yvert & Tellier: Timbres de France (Tome 1) [French]

For the advanced collector:

Cérés: France Catalogue timbres-poste [French]

Dallay: Timbres de France [French]

Both of these catalogues are no longer produced, having been consolidated into a new catalogue:

Spink / Arthur Maury: Catalogue de Timbres de France [French]

Stanley Gibbons: (green series): France is the catalogue used by most English speaking collectors.

Yvert & Tellier: Timbres de France (Tome 1) is the catalogue used by most French speaking collectors.

Spink / Maury: Catalogue de Timbres de France provides the most detail.

Michel: Europa-Katalog Band 3 Westeuropa: Frankreich is the catalogue used by most German speaking collectors.

DATES OF ISSUE

Sometimes, these can be problematic.

For the very early issues (Ceres, Napoleon) there are no official issue dates, only years.

For later issues, when philately became a serious hobby, issue dates were recorded and ultimately First Day Covers were produced.

However, it is still possible to find SG, Michel and Maury (Yvert & Tellier do not show DOIs) showing different issue dates for the same item. Sometimes they are significantly different.

Where there is such a conflict, we make a judgment call as to the appropriate YEAR of issue.

We do not sell France FDCs so the precise DOI is not an issue.

Fortunately these conflicting issue dates are a tiny fraction of FDIs.

COLOURS

Please also refer to our advice highlighted below.

Colours are very problematic as there is no universally accepted colour scheme.

Thus two different catalogues may use two different descriptors for the same colour.

Shades present an even bigger problem as the number of shades listed can vary between catalogues.

Thus matching colour descriptors with catalogue numbers is frequently very difficult, especially with the early issues.

We use SG colour descriptors and supplement these on occasion with shades from other catalogues.

Whilst we have used every care, we cannot guarantee the number matches.

Please advise us if you have found what you believe are errors.

To date, no one has provided us with such information.

ISSUES LISTED

We list the "standard" issues of France (La Poste refers to these as "philatelic" issues).

In recent years, La Poste has issued a number of "peripheral" items aimed directly at the philatelic market.

They are usually priced well above face.

We do not acquire or list such products which include story books, booklets, sheetlets and recent P-stamps.

In addition, La Poste now issues many stamps as self adhesives in sheets of 40 to 120.

They state that these products are produced for the corporate market and not the philatelic market.

They back this stance by refusing to supply such items in philatelic quantities (ie they will supply sheets only).

Thus many self adhesive items in the general price lists have blanks instead of prices.

Certain P-stamps are also restricted to the corporate market.

In addition, they also produce "documents" and "gravures" for each issue.

We do not stock these.

POTENTIALLY CONFUSING YVERT & TELLIER LISTING PRACTICES

When stamps are issued in individual sheets and also collectively in a small sheet, then the small sheet is a M/S [Block].

When a set of stamps is issued in individual sheets and some (but not all) of these are also issued in a small sheet, then the small sheet is a sheetlet [prefix "F" for "feuille"]

When stamps are issued in a small sheet only, then it is a sheetlet [prefix "F" for "feuille"]

Mini Sheets are listed separately, but the stamps they contain are listed in the main list.

Airmails are listed separately ["A" prefix for "Aériens" added by us].




Special mini sheets are given an SS prefix [for Souvenir Sheet] by us.





These should not be confused with philatelic souvenir sheets which are listed with a Blk S prefix.

Coils are listed separately.





Self adhesives, corporate and philatelic, are listed separately [AA prefix for "Autoadhésifs" added by us].


However, self adhesives issued on 8.11.08 and before, are listed twice (in the main list and the self adhesive list) resulting in dual numbers.

	Please note				Maury and Yvert & Tellier both show more shades / varieties than SG for the Ceres & Napoléon issues. This price list's colour descriptions are based upon SG. Colour matching between catalogues is very difficult as each describes shades / paper colours differently. We are not familiar with the subtleties of the French language for colours, although we reference three sources for translations. Maury & Yvert Tellier matches with SG are our best deductions. Whilst we have used every care, we can not guarantee the number matches. Customer advice on potential errors is welcome.
